Dear Parents/ Guardians,

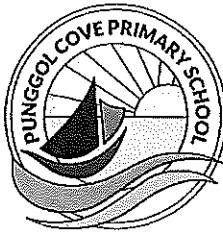
To facilitate your planning, here is an update of our activities for Term Three 2016.

JUNE 2016

- 1) **ENGLISH FIESTA (27 June to 1 July 2016)**
